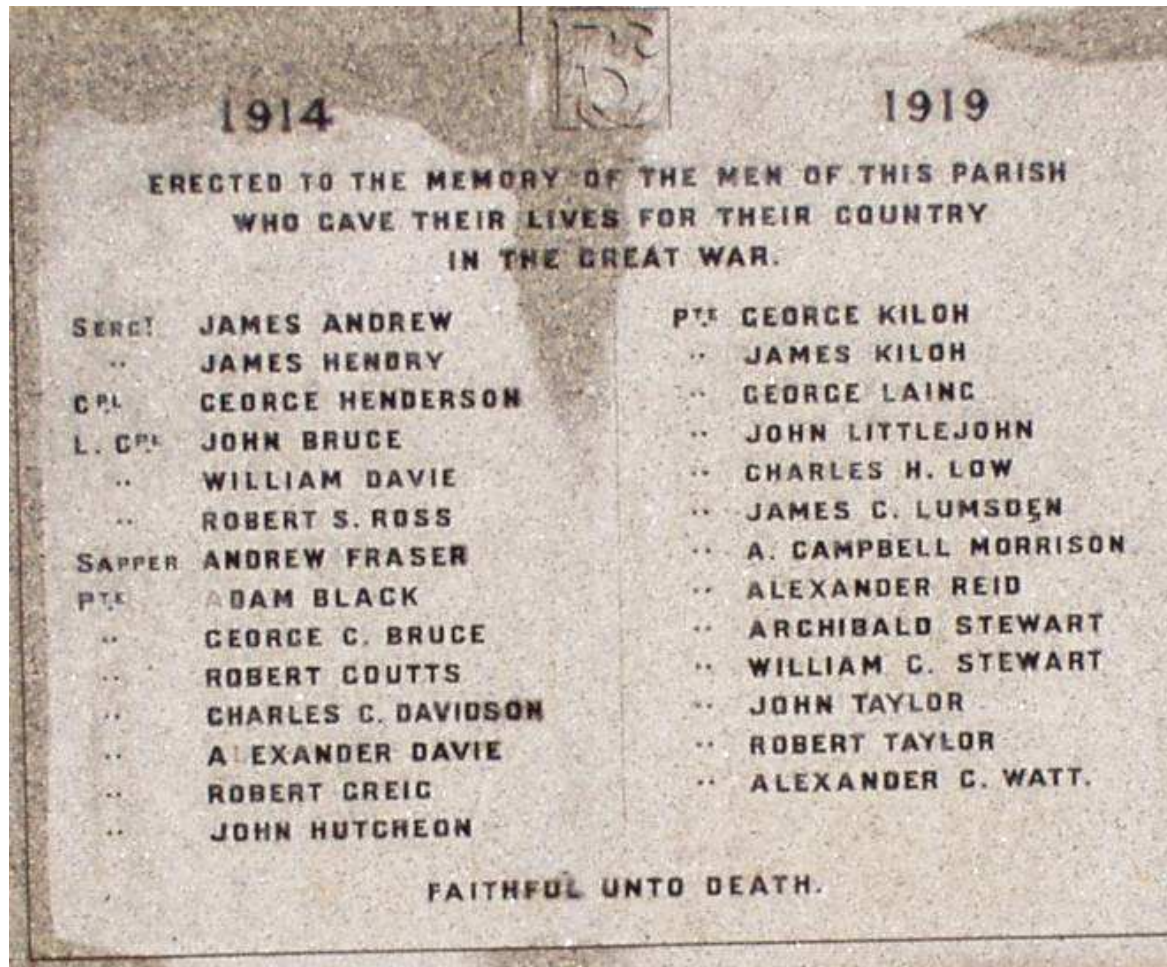


Barthol Chapel:

Sited on the west wall of the parish church is a simple granite memorial which commemorates the men lost during WWI. At the top centre are the entwined letters B & C. The memorial was unveiled 23rd November 1919. It is inscribed "Erected to the memory of the men of this parish who gave their lives for their country in the Great War" and "Faithful unto death".
