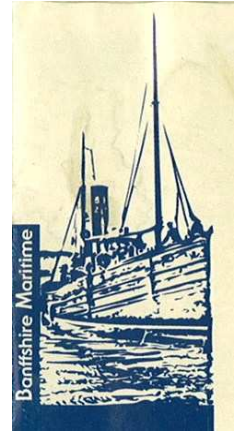

2008 PAINTING COMPETITION



Rules:

The competition is open to three categories A) Primary school classes P1 to P4, B) Primary school classes P5 to P7, C) Academy school children. Paintings must not have been previously published, self-published or published on a website or broadcast before 26th June 2008. **The closing date of the competition is 1st June 2008.** The competition is open to UK and non-UK applicants. Each painting must be given a title. All paintings will be judged anonymously and the name of the artist must not appear on the front of the painting, however it may be written on the rear. **The title of the painting must be written on the front of the painting.** Paintings must be the original work of the artist. There is no restriction on the number of paintings submitted by each applicant. Each painting will be judged separately. **Entries will only be accepted when accompanied by an entry form (forms may be photocopied).** Paintings must be of a yachting theme. Alterations cannot be made to paintings after they have been submitted. Confirmation of postal entries will only be confirmed if an SAE/postcard is enclosed. The competition organisers are NOT able to confirm receipt of entries via telephone.

Paintings must be on one side only of A4 or A3 paper or canvas, (i.e. not double-sided). Any format water-colour, chalk, oil, pencil, ink etc may be submitted.

Competition entries may be collected from Macduff Town Hall on Sunday 29th June at 4pm.

Fees:

There is no fee, entry is free.

Results:

All winners and commended artists will be personally notified before the prize-giving. The winners will be published in the 2008 BMHA exhibition, and in the local newspapers, and on the internet.

Prizes:

First prize in all categories will be a £25 Argos gift voucher plus a medal, runner-ups in all categories will be awarded medals. Winning schools will be awarded a trophy. All prizes will be awarded at the Banffshire Maritime Heritage Association Exhibition in the Town Hall Macduff on Friday the 27th June 2008 at 6.30pm.

Copyright:

The copyright of each painting remains with the artist. Artists will grant the BMHA the right to publish or display the paintings in any BMHA exhibition or future publication.

Please note:

No member of the BMHA or Association volunteer is eligible to enter.
