
I Can Sketch And Draw

I can sketch silly cylinders.




I find fingers are cylinders. Look around for cylinders.

Glasses, cups, broom handles, and trashcans are cylinders.





First draw the outside lines of a horse.

I can draw and sketch


anything.

Draw a flattened circle.


I put them together for a turtle.

Fun to draw.




With a flattened circle and a Cylinder

Shading makes them come alive.




I can draw a triangle with a flattened circle at the bottom for a cone.



I can draw a square.


I draw two squares and

I sketch a roof on it to draw a log Cabin.




I can design my own car.
