Clan Logan Historical Stats

- First known Logan of record: Adam Logan, witness to a charter by King Alexander II on 25 August 1236.
- First Logan to use a Logan seal: Walter Logan (Wautier Logyn del counte de Lanark), who in 1296, was the first Logan recorded affixing his seal to the Ragman Roll.
- First person to be known as "Logan of that Ilk": Alexander Logan, in 1516.
- First known Chief of Name and Arms of Logan: Alexander Logan of that Ilk.
- First Logan to register Arms: George Logan of that Ilk, 1672.
- Lineage of the Chief: Alexander - Patrick - William - George - William - George - George - William - Allan - Hugh – Hugh.

- Last Chief of Clan Logan: Hugh Logan of that Ilk. A book titled, "[The Laird of Logan being Anecdotes and Tales illustrative of the With and Humour of Scotland](#)," was written about this Hugh Logan of that Ilk.
- First formation of Clan Logan Society International: 1913.
- Second formation of Clan Logan Society International: 2002.
- Beginning of search for heir to chiefship of Clan Logan: 2003.
- Important/significant Logans in history:
 - Sir Walter and Sir Robert, the two Logan knights selected to accompany Sir Douglas to carry the heart of King Robert the Bruce. [Clan Logan - Wikipedia](#).
 - Walter Logan, Sheriff of Lanark.
 - The Barons of Restalrig, Sir Robert Logan of Restalrig married the sister of King Robert III of Scotland (her name is not known). Through this marriage, Sir Robert obtained the Lands of Grugar. His descendants would become the Barons of Restalrig. [Clan Logan - Wikipedia](#).
