# ACCOMMODATIONS – April 7, 2008

Click for a map of the area: <u>http://uk2.multimap.com/maps/#t=l&map=56.43754,-5.21578|12|4</u>. The two main areas of Gathering activity are Taynuilt (Thursday, Saturday afternoon, and Sunday) and Oban (Friday and Saturday nights).

**Self-Catering + B&Bs** - For groups of four or more from overseas who plan to stay in the area for two weeks and don't mind making breakfast, doing dishes and sharing the bathroom, self-catering is the **best buy**. They are rented from Saturday afternoon to the following Saturday morning. This means that if you stay only one week you will have to move to a new place on Saturday morning, which is somewhat inconvenient. On the plus side, self-catering has a private living/dining area with cooking facilities, but that means shopping for food and cooking.

### Hotels, Guest Houses and Bed & Breakfast

These are the other three choices, unless you are staying with friends. These all provide breakfast as part of the fee, but ask to be sure.

**Hotels and Lodges.** Hotels/Lodges are built expressly as lodgings. They have many more rooms than a Guest House and often, but not always, have a restaurant. Very large hotels can vary greatly in quality. I would chose smaller establishments (50 rooms or less) and, if possible, check them out at <u>www.tripadvisor.com</u> where you can read candid assessments by people like you.

**Guest Houses.** These are large homes that have been changed into a guest house. They usually have six to ten rooms with en suite bathrooms. They have a common guest lounge and a room where breakfast is served. The managers may or may not live onsite.

**Bed & Breakfast**. B&Bs are usually the home of the owner who has from one to four extra rooms available for tourists. The toilet/bathing facilities can be in the room (en suite) but can also be across the hall and sometimes are shared with other rooms (be sure to ask). Some B&Bs are large enough to be considered guest houses.

PRICE: Price isn't always a gauge of quality but can give some indication.  $\pounds 30 = US \$60+$  and is per person unless otherwise stated. The AAA star rating is probably the best guide of quality and facilities.

Where to Start? Considering the type of accommodation and the location:

1. Go below to the Specific Accommodations list of places people have already made reservations.

2. Choose two or three and go to their website where most of the questions are answered. Otherwise, telephone them directly or e-mail to get answers to any questions. A telephone call from the US usually costs 10 cents a minute and is well worth it. The time difference in the US and Scotland is 6 hours EDT, 7 hours CDT and 8 hours PDT. If you are sure you are coming, you should begin to make reservations now because July is the high season.

- a. Ask for their cancellation policy.
- b. Ask whether the toilet facilities are 'en suite' or shared with another room.
- c. Ask how long it takes to get to Oban and Taynuilt
- d. People who have difficulty walking or breathing should ask about how far they are from the public bus stop and if there is a hill to climb (e.g. Oban).
- e. People with cars should ask about parking.
- f. Tall people should ask about ceiling heights which might be lower if it is a room where the roof slants or it is a room below the ground level ("garden room"). Very few, if any, rooms will have a king or even a queen-size bed and twin beds are really twin-size beds.

Aside from ceiling height and shared facilities, we would rate the places we have stayed as good to excellent, and most importantly, clean.

## **Specific Accommodations**

Below are many lodgings where attendees have already booked <u>or</u> that are known to be convenient to the events and transportation. There are many more that are not listed that may be equally suitable. The more people staying at the same place, the easier it will be to provide transportation to and from events. We will keep you posted on new places as soon as attendees give us details. You must check to see if the place meets your needs.

**Note:** The '011 44'" prefix is for telephone calls from the U.S. & may be different for Australia etc. Don't use (0) when calling from outside the UK. When calling within the UK eliminate the 011 44 and include the (0)
