MEETING RECAP -October 2023: The Jacobite Uprising with SSI Historian

We got to learn some great history and facts regarding one of the Jacobite Uprisings in the county of Scotland. Here are some small facts - The Jacobite Rebellions were a series of uprisings aimed at restoring James VII of the House of Stuart and his successors to the throne of Great Britain during the 17th and 18th centuries. The rebellions commenced when James VII fled England, and the Dutch Protestant William of Orange and Mary II assumed the monarchy. There were several uprisings that occurred and one of the more famous ones was the uprising that took place in 1745 and later led to the Battle of Culloden.
