After a long discussion and review by the SSI Board of Trustees and our current Games/Festival committee heads - it has been decided that the Indianapolis Scottish Highland Games & Festival will not take place again this year. This was a difficult decision to make but it. was for the best for the society that we hold off another year for this event. The decision was based on a lack of a suitable or confirmed location, volunteers had diminished, committee managers are needed along with training that needs to be provided. IMPORTANT: REQUIREMENTS FOR IN-PERSON MEETINGS **UPDATE**

In-person meetings are taking place now. The board has made some requirements and set regulations we will expect moving forward until we believe it will be safe to resume as normal.

- The board will need to see proof of your vaccination card when you come to the meetings (this can be the physical card or a photo of the card).
 We will be checking for them at the door before you enter. NEW: If you have checked in before, you do not have to bring your vaccination card again - we will have a list of returning members/guests marked so you will be able to just come in
- NEW: We will be lifting the mask mandate for all those who want to attend our inperson meetings. If you wish to wear a mask to feel comfortable and safe, that is absolutely fine.
- The meetings will be a "bring your own food/drink" situation. No food or drink is to be shared, unless you feel comfortable sharing with the people you sit with at the table. That will be at your discretion. There will be no buffet style eating at any of the meetings

- until further notice.
- There will be hand sanitizer and masks for sale if needed. They will be provided at the tables and at the welcome table.
- If you as an individual are under the weather of any sort or are feeling/currently sick - we are requesting that you do not attend the meeting. Please stay at home and get better.

Note: As of January 2022, the Board of Trustees have unanimously voted and have confirmed that we will not be allowing any type of exemptions (medical or religious). Vaccination cards must be presented for your first check-in at the meetings or we will ask you to leave.

If you are not able to abide by these new updates or requests, please be aware the board may deny you entry to the meetings. Our continuous priority is to keep everyone safe and healthy. If you have any questions about this, please reach out to the board.
