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The Institution of Engineers in Scotland was founded in 1857, and the first annual volume of *Transactions* was for the year 1857-58. In 1860 the Scottish Shipbuilders' Association was formed, and issued *Proceedings* from 1860 to 1865. The annual volumes of the Association were separately paged, but not numbered, and the bound volumes were for the years 1860-63 and 1863-65.

In 1865 the two bodies amalgamated under the title of "The Institution of Engineers in Scotland, with which is incorporated the Scottish Shipbuilders' Association," and in 1875 the present title was adopted. The series of volume numbers begun in 1857 has been continued throughout.

In order to give some indication of the date of the various papers, all references to volumes are by session and not by volume number. The Proceedings of the Scottish Shipbuilders' Association are indicated by the letters S.S.A. prefixed to the date. Under each heading the entries are arranged chronologically.

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
