(i) TRANSCRIPT FROM INSIDE FRONT COVER

Andrew Buchanan Mercht. in Glasgow son of George Buchanan and Christian Mitchell there was born at Glasgow the 19th of Novembr 1725 N.S. [Some words seem to be omitted here]

Agnes Robertson Daughter of Arthur Robertson and Betty Yuille was born at Glasgow the 8th July 1736 New Stile. [New Style (misspelt New Stile and abbreviated to N.S.) refers to the Gregorian Calendar introduced in 1582 by Pope Gregory XIII and adopted in Great Britain in 1752]

Andrew Buchanan and Agnes Robertson were married the 8th July 1755 N.S. and had the following children.

Daughter Bess Buchanan born in Mitchels Land foot of the New Street on Saturday the 8th Jan'y 1757 N.S. near 11 o'clock at night.

Son George born in a Small House near Stabcross on Monday the 3rd July 1758 a Q'r before six in the morning.

Son Arthur born on the first — of Bailie Robertson's land head of the Stockwell on Wednesday the 13th day of February 1760 about half an hour past five o'clock in the morning

Agnes Robertson miscarried and was delivered 3/4 past 9 at night upon Wednesday the 5th day of Aug't 1761 at Mrs Rainie's House in Gowrock east side of the Bridge.

Agnes Robertson miscarried and was delivered of a dead son at 3/4 past 10 o'clock in the morning upon Saturday the 9th of January 1762 N.S. in Mr Alexr Campbells land in the Stockwell. The child was that evening buried by his father in Pallions Croft.

Son Arthur Buchanan departed this life upon Wednesday the 3 of March 1762 in Mr Campbells Land Stockwell at 1/2 an hour past twelve at night and was buried on Thursday the 4th half an hour after 4 at night and Laid under a small stone at the foot of his grandfather Buchanan's Lair in the High Church Yard aged 2 years 16 days and 20 hours. He dyed of the Smallpox 6 days past the height had a very bad kind of the pox bore his trouble with much patience fell into gentle fits of the draughts about 10 hours before his death. He dyed with much ease seemingly. He was pleasant & lovely in life and pleasant & lovely in death.

Agnes Robertson my wife miscarried of a child at Small House at Stabcross on Tuesday the 7th of September 1762 about 3/4 after nine o'clock in the morning.

Daughter Christian born in the House purchased by me from John Fleaming lyeing in Argyle Street on Saturday the 19th day of November 1763 a few minutes past 11 o'clock at night.

Tuesday October 15th 1765 my wife was delivered of a son 2 minutes after six o'clock in the evening Named Andrew, baptised Sunday 27th October in the North West Church, born at my House in Argyle Street - my dear and lovely son who died at sea.

Tuesday Septemr 15th 1767 at 5 minutes past 10 at night my wife was delivered of a son at my House in Argyle Street Baptised by Mr Finlay in North West Church on Sunday the 27th September named William.

Wednesday 23 Decem'r 1767 my daughter Bess Buchanan dyed of a fever suddenly about 1/2 an hour after 10 in the morning. She sickened on the Saturday evening before that. She was a most sensible obedient and sweet tempered & affectionate child. Her accomplishments seemed greatly to surpass her age which was 10 years 11 months 15 days. She was interred on Saturday the 26 at 4 at night & covered with a Stone the southmost of her Grandfather's lair her Bror deceased lyes at her Feet Memento Mori.

Friday January 29th 1768 my daughter Christian Buchanan dyed of a fever & mortification on her throat occasioned therby at 3/4 of an hour after nine in the morning being the 22nd day of her slow & painfull sickness. She was a most comely strong & healthy child vastly sweet & engageing aged four years two months nine & a half days. She was interred on Monday the 1st of Feb in the same grave immediately above the body of her sister Bess. As they were fond of each other in life & used to lye together in one bed their bodies now Iye together in one grave & I hope their souls now glorify God together. Memento Mori. A B.

Tuesday December 20th 1768 my son William Buchanan dyed of convulsions occasioned by teething suddenly 5 minutes before one o'clock midday he sickened on the Sabbath evening immediately preceding, so had only about two days. He was a strong and beautiful healthy child aged one year three months four days and one half of a day. He was interrred on Thursday the 22nd about 11 o'clock forenoon his body lyes at the side of his brother Arthur's north side on the High Church Yard. Both are covered with one stone lyeing North & South but the corpses lye east and west. Memento Mori. A.B.

Friday 14th July 1769 My wife was delivered of a son 15 minutes past 4 o'clock in the morning at my house in Argyle Street. She was very ill of him. Soon after his birth he fell into a faint, Received back from death in a figure. Baptised in my house on acct. of his weakness on Friday 11th August 1769, 10 in the morn'g by Mr Telfer of Kilsyth named Robertson in memory of his dear dead mother. Memento Mori A.B.

Upon Wednesday the 2nd of Aug't 1769 at 8 o'clock at night precisely, By the Sovereign will of Almighty God after 18 days trouble in child bed. Fell asleep in the Lord Jesus Christ His Servant Agnes Robertson my dear & much valued & much beloved wife. A good child from her infancy, a good relation, a kind affectionate & good wife, a valuable mother, a good mistress. A sincere Christian, aged 33 years 25 days. Married the day she was 19, in that state 14 years 25 days, a short but a useful life. She was a very beautiful strong healthy woman of the middle size of a strong broad shape pretty tall & lusty. She was remarkably cheerful, of a delightful temper that shone thro' her face in continual smiles.

Her body was interred on Saturday the 3rd August at 8 at night precisely in the New North West Church Yard on the West Wall in Lair No.50 containing a breadth for corpses in the second breadth counting from the northward. 50 is also the number of the pew or seat in the North West Church in which she used with much pleasure to hear Mr Rob't Finlay Minister all the time of her married life unto the great giver and the great taker of His great earthly Blessing & to his dear Son and to the ever Blessed Spirit be all Praise & Glory & Honour for ever & ever Amen. Among her last words was the expression that she had no desire to live any longer here but that she wished to be with her dear dear Redeemer. Memento Mori. A.B.

Monday the 3rd December 1770. Andrew Buchanan was then married to Janet Niven daughter of Hugh Niven and Margaret Fleaming. Janet Niven was born at Glasgow the 2nd

day of January 1746 New Stile at 2 o'clock in the morning.

Saturday the 16 Nov'r 1771 at 3/4 after 4 o'clock in the afternoon my wife was delivered of a son at my house in Argyle Street. Baptised by Mr McCulloch of Bothwell on Monday the 18th his name Hugh. He dyed on Wednesday the 20th about 1/4 after 3 o'clock in the morning and was entered in my Lair No. 50 in the New North West Church Yard on Thursday the 21st 1/2 an hour after nine o'clock in the morning aged 3 days 10 hours.

Thursday the 22d October 1772 at 40 minutes after two o'clock in the morning at the Sovereign will of her God departed this mortal Life trusting in her Soul's passage thro' the Valley of Death in him alone as she expressed it meaning the merits of her Mediator his sincere Servant Janet Niven aged 26 years 20 days & 40 minutes. She had been long in trouble which she bore with much patience and resignation. Dyed of a nervous or paralitick trouble having lost her sight some days before. She was a beautiful woman black complexion of a very fine shape a little above the middle size. She was a most kind dutiful affectionate wife, a stepmother that had the temporal & eternal welfare of my children at heart. She was a most dutiful obedient child to her parents, an affectionate sister. She had a most engageing and sweet address so much that she was beloved by all that knew her from her very infancy. Her body was interred on Monday Oct 26 at 5 o'clock afternoon on the South Boundary of my Lair in New North West Church yard No. 50 into the same grave with her son Hugh whose coffin was for that purpose lowered down. O that I may meet with her and all my other near & dear relations at the resurrection of the justified by Christ Jesus there to be freed of all trouble & pain & sorrow forever thro him who is over all God blessed for ever. Memento Mori Amen.

Sunday the 12th September 1773 precisely at 9 o'clock in the morning by the will of God Almighty departed this short life George Buchanan Senr my father, son of George Buchanan & Mary Maxwell born at Glasgow the supposed 1685 in the time of Episcopacy aged about 88 years. A strong healthy well made well looking man, well disposed, plain & honest, universally esteemed, universally regarded. He died of a pleurisy, was not bled for it, though strong – walked in room with help 1/4 of an hour before death. He was much obstructed, could not eat or drink for some days breathed with much difficulty & great pain on his side & endwards. I waited very close on him for some days & nights. He was interred beside his father & mother wives & children in my lair opposite the principal door of the High Church. Memento Mori.

Monday 28 Feb'y 1774 Andrew Buchanan was then married to Francis Innes, Daughter of Alexander Innes & Francis Frank. Francis Innes was born at Bastare on the Island of St Kitts.

Tuesday 3rd January 1775 at 20 minutes past six in the afternoon my wife Francis Innes was delivered of a daughter at my home in Argyle Street. 14 days afterwards the child Baptised by Mr Garrick of Baldernock, named Francis.

Monday 15 January 1776. At 42 minutes after 8 in the morning my wife was delivered of a son — Baptised Alexander on the 22d at 5 at night by Dr. Reid of the Collage. Sunday 4 Feby 1776 a few minutes before 3 o'clock afternoon departed this life Alexander Buchanan my son aged 20 days 68 hours — of severe inwood trouble & sore mouth, never took the breast rightly from his birth but mourned much in his sleep — he was to appearance a strong beautiful and large child. He was buryed Tuesday the 6th Feb at 8 past 11 forenoon in Lair No. 50 New North West Church Yard above the coffin of my first wife. Memento Mori.

Saturday 11 January 1777 at about 3/4 after one in the morning my wife was delivered of a Daughter. Baptised on Monday the 3rd of February her name Janet.

Monday 13 July 1778 at 10 minutes to 11 o'clock p.m. my wife was delivered of a daughter. Baptised on Friday 24 July by Doctor Reid of the Colledge – named Mary.

Tuesday 24 October 1780 at 5 minutes before 9 o'clock forenoon my wife Frances Innes was delivered of a son. Baptised on Thursday 9th October by Doctor Thomas Reid of the Colledge named John Oswald.

Upon Friday the 24 Decemr 1779 my much lamented and dearest and best of sons Andrew took his leave of me never to meet again in this world. Setting out to Jamaica on his second voyage on ship Mermaid [with] Capt. John Bowie. He wrote me from Port Moran 13 May 1780 and from Port Royal the 23 Augt 1780 & says he hoped to find me and all friends well in three months – his hopes and my most earnest desire were not consistent with the will of the Almighty Giver of Life. In him I have lost the joy and delight of my heart, the comfort of distressed and declining years – but want to submit my will to the Will of the Lord God Almighty. May I meet with him in everlasting peace and happiness thro' the Righteousness of Christ – may I meet the poor young sailor in the Heaven of Glory.

He was born on the 15 Oct'r 1765 on the 5 day of Nov' 1780 Mermaid was taken in long 30 lat 45 by the Essex, American privateer – He was left on board the Mermaid who was much disabled in the engagement and was 13 weeks at sea before she reached Salem in great distress. 16 of her hands died in that time of which he was one. Captain Bowie writes Mr R. Mackay that he sincerely laments his death as a promising well behaved young man and pity me his father, May God Almighty's pity be extended upon me. On 5 Apl last I heard of the ship's being taken at and before and since that time had strong forebodings by dreams & thoughts.

On Saturday 7 May 1781 at 11 o'clock a.m. I recd the acc't in a letter from his grandfather and to his father from Mrs Mackay by a copy of a paragraph of Capt. Bowie's letter relating to him.

His age could be but 15 years and a month or some days more. A short life but full of activity. He was thin made but strong nervous and hardy, capable of much fatigue and very fit for his Business. Bold & hardy of a beautiful countenance. Limbs well proportioned & straight shape. A fond understanding very sharp & quick of the most humane & amiable dispositions. He was much delighted with his first Voyage and with the King's Ship La Prudence his convoy home.

The state of slavery in Jamaica he expressed to be contrary to his feelings. He took out a very small venture with his first voyage with which he bought himself cloaths on his return and brot for my use small quantitys of tea sugar rum coffee chocolate tobacco & spices. He brought me savory food from afar. He was entirely free from guile and not ashamed to work at the meanest work where he thought it would serve

He suffered much from the cruelty of the wretched band and the prizes master & mate and dyed of famine as did all the other 15. This I had from one Rob't Watson that was couper of the Vessel and witness to it. I went to Ain to get the cruel information from him. The Sands of Ain, the Mairns Muirs the Bare's of Cathkine are witnesses of the agony of my feelings for what my dearest dead son must have suffered by a death of such inexpressible misery.

(ii) TRANSCRIPT FROM INSIDE BACK COVER

An account of the predecessors of me Andrew Buchanan from tradition.

My great great grandfather Alexr Buchanan lived at his Estate called Glenie in Perthshire. He was a branch of the family of Buchanan of Lenie.

Andrew Buchanan son to the former married a woman of the name of Buchanan and lived with her on his estate of Gartacharan, Water of Enrick Stirlingshire.

George Buchanan second son of the above named arrived and settled at Glasgow about the year 16_ married a woman named Smith no descent. Account from Register: May 2 1685

George Buchanan married Mary Maxwell daughter of Maxwell Merchant by his wife Elisa Cuming & Mary Maxwell born 24 April 1662 married privately in the house of Craig in Troan Estate. G.B. was Mrs Maxwell's second Husband.

G.B. was then an outlaw of the then tyrannical Government and a reward offered for taking him either dead or alive. He carried arms openly ag't the Government especially was hotly pursued by the Duke of Monmouth at Bothwell Bridge after that unfortunate engagement. He had been a very strong man but his constitution was broken with the hardships he suffered in a good cause.

Mary Maxwell was married to her first husb'd John Scott 31st Dec'r 1681.

George Buchanan son of G.B. & M.M. Born 3rd June 1686 - He was my father.

After the Revolution G.B. my grandfather elected by Poll voting Treasurer of Glasgow for year 1690. Trade Bailie 1695 1698 1702 & 1705.

G.B. my father Convenor 1706 1706 1707 Councilor 1712 Treasurer 1726 Gorbals Bailie 1727 Bailie 1732 1735 1738 Andrew Buchanan Second Bro'r to above Provost 1740.

Neile Buchanan third bro'r. Member of Parl't for Glasgow 1740.

Arch'd Buchanan fourth bro'r Bailie.

These three bro's were men remarkable for honour honesty and Estates. Andrew was a very wise sagatious man somewhat reserved. Neile was a very free & open man, his person & manner beautiful & engaging, in trade very bold & very successful.

Arch'd a man of great goodness of heart, avoided shining in public. He had the welfare of his relations and the welfare of Mankind much at heart. He seemed possessed of great peace of mind the result of virtue, impressed also with & uncertainty of life. All of them dyed what may be called young, they had done much in a short time.

These brothers left the Maj'ty of Councils of Glasgow in the year 1743.

Sunday 1 September 1782. Francis Innes my wife delivered of a daughter at 1/2 an hour after three o'clock in the morning. Baptised on Wednesday 2 Octotr in the afternoon by W. Furlong Minister of Rutherglen. Name Ann.

On Wednesday the 3 December 1783 at 1 o'clock afternoon departed this life to the inexpressible grief of his parents their dear dear Son John Oswald Buchanan aged 3 years 1 month 9 days & four hours of the effects of a cold that affected his head. After 11 days of serious trouble in which he was closely attended by his poor Mother he used to cry in agony "Mother, mother, my head my heady." He was a very beautiful and strong healthy & easy brought up & very fine shape & countenance eyes & complexion. He had almost love for his father as he called him & for his dearest mother. Buried Saturday 6 Dec'r 1783 at 1 o'clock Burying place North West Churchyard No. 50. Memento Mori.

G.B. eldest son of Andrew Buchanan left his father's house in May 1774, then 15 years and 10 months of age, arrived in Virginia in June, remained there and in North Carolina till July 1776; then on his way home visited the islands of St Eustatius St Christopher, Mountserat and Antigua; at the last remained 6 weeks; had 3 weeks there at that time; took Cork in his way to his father's house, where he arrived in December 1776; & in Dec'r 1777 sailed for Jamaica, where he arrived 17th Jan'y 1778.

He finally returned to England with his three youngest children, Andrew, Robertson and Agnes in 1816. He spent the last years of his life at Sherborne, Dorset, in retirement, highly respected by the few who knew him, his time being devoted to preparing himself for another world. He died 22nd April 1826 aged 68 years, and was buried in a vault in Sherborne Church.

He was born at Stabcross near Glasgow on the 3rd of July 1758 & was married at Content. St Georges, Jamaica to Jane Gowie, 2nd August 1795. She was born 1st April 1777.

Elizabeth Sheriff born at Iter Boreale 18 Septtr 1796.

Susan Jane born at Iter Boreale 31st Dec'r 1797 departed this life at Iter Boreale 2nd Dec'r 1799.

Francis born at Hay & Hall 8th July 1799, departed this life at Come Lee, St George's 23rd Feb 1801.

George, born at Come Lee, St George's 23rd Febty 1801, died at Trinity, Newfoundland in Dec'r 1834 aged 33 years.

Alexander, born at Iter Boreale 13th Dec'r 1802 died at Peebles in Scotland 24th Nov'r 1807.

Catherine, born at Come Lee, St Georges 20th Oct.1804 died 12th Dec'r 1813.

A girl still born at Iter Boreale 17th Nov'r 1806.

Andrew, born at Healthfield St. Ann's 10th Dec'r 1807.

Robertson, born at Wilton, St. Ann's, 16 April 1810.

Jane, wife of the above named George Buchanan died 14th Aug. 1815 at St. Ann's, Jamaica, aged 38.

Andrew, son of the above named George Buchanan of Jamaica and grandson of Andrew Buchanan, Merchant, Glasgow, settled at Ratcliff Cross, Middlesex, as a general practitioner of medicine in 1833. He was married at Broadwater Church, near Worthing, Sussex, 8th May 1834, to Emma, youngest daughter of John Harkness, surgeon of Ratcliff; he being then 26 and she 21 years old.

Their offspring:

Emma, born at Ratcliff July 2nd 1835, in the same room where her mother was born 22 years before. She was christened at St. Dunstan's Stepney 4th Sept. 1835.

Agnes, born at Ratcliff 18 Feby. 1837 and christened at St. Dunstan's, Stepney. 17 March 1837.

Edith Mary, born at Ratcliff 17th November 1838 christened in June or July 1839 at St. Thomas's, Stepney & registered in St. Dunstan's Stepney.

Fanny Chaytor, born at Ratcliff 13th April 1841, and christened and registered at St.Thomas's Church, Stepney, 22nd April 1841.

Janet Curling, born 27th March 1843 and christened at St. Dunstan's, Stepney, 21st April 1843.

My dear wife, Emma Buchanan, was delivered, at eight months, of a still born female child, on the 15 Dectr 1844. During Dec'r 1844 all my five children had the scarlet fever favorably. The rash was well out on the skin in all of them and, thanks be to Almighty God!, not one had any dangerous symptom. My eldest daughter, Emma had the hooping cough in 1836.

Arthur Vaudrey, born at Ratcliff, 26th Jan'y 1846 & christened at St. Dunstan's, Stepney in March 1846.

In the spring of 1847 my five youngest children had the hooping cough favorably.

Noel Lee, born at Ratcliff, 6th March 1848, and christened at St Dunstan's at the end of the same month.

In May 1848 my six eldest children had measles favorably.

Emily Batson, born at Heath House, Stepney, 6th of April 1850, and christened at the parish church the middle of May.

Noel Lee, second son of the abovenamed Andrew Buchanan, married in 1875 Jane McLaren Bathgate, third daughter of John Bathgate, District Judge at Dunedin, New Zealand. They had 3 children - daughter Silvia Mary born 11th September 1876. George Harkness

born 19th February 1878 and Phyllis Lee born 12th September 1881, and married 18th March 1909 to Charles Richmond Fell, barrister and solicitor, Nelson, New Zealand.

Alexr Buchanan Esq. of Glenie Perthshire of the House of Lenie. Mar'd Jean, daur of John McFarlane Esq 1666. See Douglas's Baronets of Scotland page 196.

Andrew Buchanan Esq of Gartacharan near the water of Enrick, Stirling. Mar'd a Miss Buchanan & lived on their Estate. His 2nd son George settled at Glasgow 1670 mar'd a Miss Smith, no issue.

George Buchanan Esq. mar'd July 2 1685 Mary daur of Gabriel Maxwell, Merchant Glasgow & Elizabeth Cuming, born 24 April 1662. G.B. a staunch Covenanter fought at the Battle of Bothwell Bridge in defence of his religion, a reward was offered for his Head. See History of Glasgow.

George Buchanan Esq of Glasgow born 3rd June 1686, mar'd Christian Mitchell of Glasgow born 19 Nov. 1725, was Convenor in 1706 1707 Concillor 1712 Treasurer 1726 Bailie 1727 1732 1735 & 1738. He died at Glasgow 12 Sept 1775 aged 88. See the History of Buchanan's & Glasgow.

Andrew Buchanan Esq. Merchant Glasgow. Born 19 Nov. 1725. Married 8 July 1755 Agnes daughter of Arthur Robertson & Betty Yuille, born 8 July 1736. Aged 21, died 2nd Aug 1769 aged 33. Married 2nd, Janet Niven 3 Dec 1770 Born 2 Jan'y 1746 died 22nd Oct 1772 aged 26 years 20 days & 40 minutes. Married 3rd, Francis of St Kitts 28 Feb'y 1774 died.

George Buchanan Esq. Merchant & Planter Jamaica. Born 3rd July 1758. Married at Jamaica 5th April 1795 to Miss Jane Gowie born 1st April 1777. She died 14th August 1815 aged 38, at St.Anne's Jamaica. He died at Sherborne 1826 aged 68.

Andrew Buchanan Esq Surgeon at Ratcliff Stepney. Born at Jamaica 10th Dec'r 1807. Married 8 May 1834 Emma daughter of John Harkness Esq, Surgeon Ratcliff. 1st daughter, Emma Buchanan, born at Ratcliff Cross, 2nd July 1835, in the same room where her mother was born 22 years before. 2nd daughter, Agnes Buchanan, born at Ratcliff Cross, 18th Feb'y 1837. Baptised at Stepney Church 17th March 1837 by the Rev Evan James Curate.
