Gourdon: The memorial commemorates the dead of WW1 and WW2 and is a tall granite pillar mounted on a triple granite step. There is a carved wreath on the front and it is inscribed with "To the memory and in honour of the men from Gourdon who gave their lives for their country in the struggle for righteousness and freedom in the Great War of Nations 1914 – 1918". And also "In memory of the men of Gourdon who fell on active service in the Second World WAR 1939 – 1945".
