

King Edward:

The granite memorial commemorates the dead of World War 1 and stands at the side of the A947 adjacent to the new King Edward Parish Church (The old church stands about 1/2 mile west). A simple carved wreath with the words 'In remembrance 1914 - 1919' is the centrepiece of the memorial. Each side of the memorial has a carved cross.
