
Leslie War Memorial.

The war memorial is sited on the gable wall of the parish church in the village of Leslie. The memorial commemorates the dead of WW1 (16 names) and WW2 (2 names). It is quite a small memorial made of polished granite. The top has a wreath and the dates 1914 and 1919 carved in relief. It is engraved "Erected by public subscription in memory of the undermentioned officers and men of Leslie Parish who died on service during the Great War".
