Whitehills:

The memorial is a tall granite polished pillar sitting on a double plinth; it commemorates the dead of World War One and World War Two. It is inscribed "To the greater glory of God and in memory of the men of the parish of Boyndie who made the supreme sacrifice in the Great War". It has names engraved on the front and the back and on the two sides are bronze effigies of a sailor and a soldier.
