Ardallie:

The memorial sculpted from granite commemorates WWI and WWII.

Inscribed "In Memory of the men from this parish who sacrificed their lives in the great war" and "Greater love hath no man than this" and also "Erected by the parishioners and friends".

"Ardallie is a scattered farming and commuter area covering the former ecclesiastical parish, stretching to approximately eleven square miles from Lenabo in the north east to the Hill of Dudwick in the south west. With no real built-up area as its hub," www.buchanweb.org
