Auchindor Parish:

Sited in **Lumsden** at the side of the main through fare. Made from granite it comprises of a cross with a wheel head and a carved sword and sheath, standing on a pedestal and two steps. It was made by D. Morren and Co, Holland Street, Aberdeen. The memorial commemorates men lost during WWI. Inscribed "Their name liveth for evermore" and "They died in war that we may live in peace".


