## **Rayne Parish:**

Sited adjacent to the parish church the war memorial is a granite Celtic cross with interlacing surmounting an angled base with lettering on the front, standing on a double step of rough dressed granite. It commemorates the dead of World War 1. It was made by W. McKay and Son, Holland Street, Aberdeen and is inscribed 'To the glory of God and in memory of those connected with the parish of Rayne who fell in the Great War 1914 – 1918'.

Note: the three names at the bottom are out of synchronisation with the rest and may be WW2 names.
