

Stuartfield:

The war memorial is situated just inside the gate of the cemetery. It commemorates the dead of World War One and Two. It is a granite Celtic cross elaborately carved standing on a double dressed granite plinth which stands on a three tier base. It is engraved on all four sides with names of the dead and in the front “To the glory of God, and in grateful remembrance of the men of this parish who gave their lives for their king and country in the Great War 1914 – 1919”.
