

Rare Masonic Arm's Engraving-Restores Great Seal History

The arms of the most "Ancient and Honorable Fraternity of Free and Accepted Masons" together with the "Arms of the Operative or Stone Mason's" Guild. An edition of two thousand were printed by Kinnan & Leacock, March 29, 1784. Robert Scot is documented as the engraver of this Masonic Arms plate. This is the single most important evidence that proves by simple comparison with the 1st original "US Great Seal" impression to the bird in the

Masonic arms plate that Scot engraved in 1778. This is the evidence that restores Robert Scot's place in American History.

Documented history that can "allow" today's Freemasons to build a better bridge for future Masons and put an end to the negative conspiracy theories associated to the origins of the Seal history and Freemasonry. The 1st original Great Seal is no where to be found! Below:Note the identical heads and the hook type

talons. The Seal shows the bent legs, this represents the Chevron symbol. Scot is a bloodline of the Scott-Buccleuch-Pitlochie family of Scotland. His gr-gr-maternal grandfather is St. Clair Acheson. The worlds oldest MasonicLodge records are from his grandfathers lodge in Salt Preston. St. Clairs of Herdmanston, took the name Acheson. Achesons, were heads of the Royal mint of Scotland. This is why Scot worked at the US Mint.
