

INTRODUCTORY NOTE

Most subjects are arranged in groups. The main groups are under the headings: Agreements and Undertakings; Architectural features; Buildings; Church Buildings, and subsequent headings commencing with the word 'Church'; Clergy and Religious; Customs and Services; Emissaries and Agents; Goods and Merchandise; Injuries and Compensation; Legal Functionaries, and subsequent headings commencing with the adjective 'Legal'; Livestock; Occupations; Offences and Penalties; Officials and Servants; Records; Rights; Towns and Ports; Troops; Victuals and Supplies; Wardrobes and Households; Warfare, operations in; Weapons and Armour.

References to certain general subjects which occur frequently in the calendar have been distributed over a number of specific headings. Thus references concerning 'Lands, fees or fiefs' can be found under: Agriculture; Alienations; Baronies and Lordships; Customs and Services; Earldoms; Farms and Rents; Forfeitures and Escheats; Honours; Liberties and Franchises; Manors; Mills; Seisin and Disseisin; Tenants; Tenures; Rentals and Rights, as well as the heading 'Lands'. Similarly, references concerning 'Payments' and 'Imprests' are noted under: Costs and Prices; Debts; Exchequer, warrants to; Farms and Rents; Fines and Amercements; Injuries and Compensation; Payments; Pensions; Purchase and Sale; Ransoms; Taxation; Troops, payments and prests to; and Victuals and Supplies, purchased.
